At yesterday's TCS Supt. meeting we were informed BPSH has had 4 OSHA injuries since Valentine's Day!

- * We're up to 9 OSHA's for 2003, with many being hand injuries.
- * Our 2003 OSHA rate went from 0.58 to 1.14 with target for the year being 0.80. Need to do our part to help folks stay focussed.
- * Might be time for hand-related HSE newsletter as f/u to CBT we issued in 2002.

Environmental incidents YTD are about 12 with 120 as new target. We need to average around 10/month to meet target.

Interesting point from Rick Hale:

We have 18 BP refineries in the world. Lord Browne looks at monthly data for 17 of 18 refineries all together. He looks at TCR data separately each and every month! This brings some big focus and opportunities to BPSH. Lord Browne realizes the significance of TCR to BP and BPSH. This certainly helps put the importance of the TCR to BPSH in perspective.
